It is assumed this is the Roman Catholic burying ground at the Augustinian Abbey in the grounds of the Dinsmore textile works on the Greenfield Road in Kells.  
All 30 entries are in similar handwriting suggesting they were compiled simultaneously.  
No transfers or subsequent registrations have been recorded.
